

Wanted: Information on Major Murray L. Smith, Helix 22/Ascot 04, a FAC who flew for the 21st TASS and as an O-2 instructor at Binh Thuy instructor February to December 1967. See Murray's picture below. (Wanted-200406)

I am trying to locate any FAC pilots who might have known my father, Maj. Murray L. Smith, USAF (deceased, 1967). My father arrived as a Captain in Vietnam at the beginning of February 1967 and flew FAC missions in the O-1 assigned to the US Army. Halfway through his tour, he was assigned as an IP to the Theater Indoctrination School at Binh Thuy and attained the rank of Major as well. On December 12, 1967 while on a training mission with another Pilot, his O-2 crashed. Flown to Yokohama, Japan for medical care he died on December 21, 1967. He was also an IP at Moody AFB in the early, mid '60s, T-33 and T-37.

Your assistance would be greatly appreciated in trying to locate anyone who might have known him. **I was eight years old when he left for Vietnam.**
